- **Research papers:** a full paper describing their work, maximum of 6 single-spaced pages including illustrations and results. The first page should include the title; the name of the author(s) and their affiliations; the abstract; and key words. IEEE paper format will be used.
- Short papers: research and master degree students are encouraged to participate in the conference by submitting short papers with a maximum of 2 single-spaced

Evaluation Process:

All submitted papers will go through a double-blind review process. Each paper will be evaluated by at least two reviewers. The evaluation is based on technical merits, soundness of results, clarity of presentation, and the importance and usefulness of the research topic. Before final acceptance, all reviewers' comments should be considered. Accepted papers will be published in the conference proceedings. Extended versions of best papers will be considered for publication by JATIT which is widely distributed and indexed journal.

Conference Venue:

PICCIT 2015 is scheduled to take place in October when the city of Hebron has a nice climate condition. Located in the southern part of the West Bank, about 25 kilometers to the south of Jerusalem and about 1000 meters above sea level, the holy city of Hebron has a population of ~ 800,000 people. Tours around the city of Hebron and Bethlehem will be organized for participants.

Other Activities and Events:

The conference welcomes the establishment of some special events for Jerusalem, such as workshops or presentations on how the technology can service the demand for our right to Jerusalem as the capital of the Palestinian state. The videos that are integrated with the technology for the same purpose are also welcomed.
